

The past simple

To be : I was- You were- He/ she / it was- We were - You were- They were

THE PAST SIMPLE → when the action is ended. No links with the present.

1) Affirmative form

The regular verbs

Base verbale + ED

Ex: I worked / you danced / they looked

The irregular verbs

By heart ☺

Ex : Drank / went/ did / saw / read....

2) Interrogative form

Verb "to be " → **Was ou were + subject + complements**

Ex: Yesterday, were you late for your appointment to the dentist?

Others verbs (regular and irregular) → **Did + subject + base verbale + complements**

Ex: Did you travel to Spain last year?

3) Negative form

Verb "to be " → **subject + was not / were not + complements**

Ex: They were not satisfied of their holidays. They weren't satisfied of their holidays.

Other verbs → **subject + did not / didn't + base verbale + complements.**

Ex: I did not watch this movie yesterday evening. I didn't watch this movie yesterday evening.
